COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course provides a multidisciplinary review and update on the diagnosis and management of patients with breast carcinoma. The presentations will focus on recent diagnostic and therapeutic advances, and emphasize their practical implications. Some of the lectures will include discussion of the results of experimental studies to highlight recent progress in the understanding of breast carcinoma and future directions for its treatment.

The course faculty consists of a cadre of experts in the diagnosis and treatment of breast carcinoma from European centers and from the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in the US.

The course is intended for physicians and nursing staff involved in the care of patients with breast carcinoma, who wish to broaden their knowledge of the disease.

Upon completing this course, participants will:

- understand benefits and limitations of the latest techniques for the radiologic detection of breast carcinoma;
- understand the principles underlying the pathologic classification of breast carcinoma and their implications for patient care;
- understand the benefits and limitations of sentinel lymph node biopsy in the management of patients with breast carcinoma;
- Understand the latest concepts and options for diagnosis and treatment of patients with breast carcinoma
- Familiarize themselves with organizational schemes aimed to maximize the efficiency in the delivery of clinical care to patients with breast carcinoma.
